August

National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Children's Day (Children's Day) is the national day dedicated to celebrating children. Children's Day is celebrated across the country each year on 4 August. Children's Day is a time Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander families and communities and all Australians, celebrate the strengths and culture of children. It is an opportunity to show support for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children, as well as learn about the crucial impact that culture, family and community play in the life of every Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander child. Children's Day has been run annually since 1988 and is the initiative of SNAICC – National Voice for our Children.

The Children's Day 2020 theme: 'We are the Elders of tomorrow, hear our voice' honours Elders – custodians of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander traditional knowledge, passed down to our children through stories and cultural


