Incredible Years is an evidence based, proven program that strengthens parenting skills and confidence and improves children's social and emotional behavior for families with children aged between 4 and 12 years.

Would you like to:

- Learn about how you can reduce your child's challenging behaviours
- Have strategies to increase the behaviours you would like to see more of
- Build your child's self-esteem and positive social skills
- Learn how to give your child the attention they need in positive and fun ways
- Introduce household rules that support positive behaviour and relationships
- Learn from and with other parents who want these things too

RESOURCES & SUPPORT FOR PARENTS

Calm Kid Central (CKC) is developed and run by child psychologists to help kids with “big feelings” and challenges and to support parents. Child psychologists are on standby to answer questions and concerns about your children within 48 hours. There is also access to videos, activity sheets, articles, discussion questions and other ideas that can support children’s wellbeing, development and dealing with challenging behaviour. Topics include;

- Helping Kids Get Along With Others
- Helping Kids with Frustration and Tricky Behaviour
- Helping Kids with Worry, Anxiety and Stress
